MUSEUM

Located on the third floor of the Anvil Centre, the New Westminster Museum cares for over 36,000 objects that celebrate our city's stories and history. Taking you on a journey from 10,000 years ago through today, our exhibits focus on the land, people and development of the place we call New Westminster. We are a fun and entertaining place of learning and use the objects in the Museum's collection as an entry-point to inquiry, discussion and exploration about the City.

ARCHIVES

Visit the archives to learn about the history of your community, lost relatives, significant historical events or facts about older homes. Located on the second floor of Anvil Centre.

TOURS

Guided group tours can be booked for New Westminster Museum at Anvil Centre or Irving House on weekdays for \$50 (groups of 1-15) or \$100 (groups of 16-30).

OTHER HERITAGE SITES

Be sure to check out the other heritage sites the City has to offer. Irving House at 302 Royal Avenue is the oldest intact house in the Lower Mainland, built in 1865 by riverboat captain William Irving and interpreted to the Victorian era.

Located by the River Market, the 1937 Samson V snag-boat is BC's last steam-powered sternwheeler. This former working ship tells the story of the Fraser Port. Admission at both sites is by donation.

CELEBRATING BLACK HISTORY IN CANADA THROUGH TESSELLATION AND PORTRAITURE

Anvil Centre | GALLERY 2

Moved by a push for greater social justice, NWSS Art students researched prominent figures from Black History in Canada and share their contributions in black and white tessellation patterns and portraits. Equal parts 'black' and 'white' in these works challenges a Eurocentric-lens that is too often applied when discussing history by featuring People of Colour (POC) and Black Canadians in an equally starring role. Each student provides a thoughtful artist statement with their portrait.

This exhibition replicates the original class work, design, and display.

RECONCILING

Anvil Centre | GALLERY 7

Through three installations, Reconciling addresses truths attached to acts of reconciliation. Haida/Nisga'a artist Luke Parnell explores a feeling of disenchantment through his piece Neon Reconciliation Explosion; the downed statue of Judge Begbie addresses the imposition of foreign laws on a land; and the 215 shoes placed at New Westminster's cenotaph reflects our community's response to the Residential School legacy in Canada.
